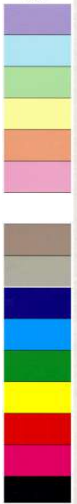
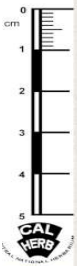

Veget. type: Dry, evergreen sub forest. Assoc. plants: *Polygonum*, *Citrus* etc.  
Distribution: Frequent in shady forest.  
Leg: floor.
