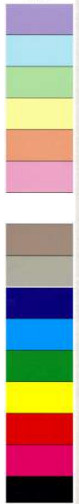
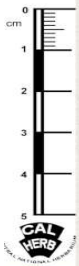

lobed.

Host plants: *Polygonum*, *Citrus* etc.
Distribution: Frequent in shady forest
Leg: floor.
