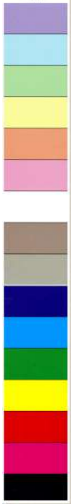

GENUS & SPECIES: *Lencas zeylanica* Pr.

LOCALITY: Near Tapatala, 2 miles west of Nakhola.  
HABITAT: Clay loam, blackish brown with abundant moisture, in paddy fields, alt. 175 m.

DISTRIBUTION: Very common in open places on banks of cultivated fields.  
DESCRIPTION: Erect herb about 30 cm. tall, much branched ascendingly, white flowers in axillary and terminal thyrses.
