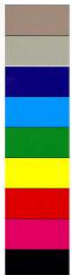
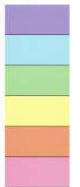

Uses: [Leaves are used as galactagogue. Leaves poultice is applied to swellings and bufoes. Poultice of roots are used to treat ulcers, sinuses, swellings and boils. Pulverized roots are used to treat dysentery. Decoction of roots are used in treatment of fever, diarrhea and dysentery. Latex is astringent, antiseptic and applied to sore heels, chapped hands and glandular swellings. Seeds are used in epistaxis, piles, diarrhea and applied externally as paste in](#)
